The SMART (Skills Mastery and Resistance Training) Moves program is a prevention and education program designed to address problems such as drug and alcohol abuse and premature sexual activity. This program is broken into three age-appropriate modules: SMART Kids (ages 6 to 9), Start SMART (ages 10 to 12) and Stay SMART (ages 13 to 15). Young people today are faced with so many messages – in the media, from their peers and in the world around them – encouraging them to engage in unhealthy behaviors. The program is designed to teach youth ages 6 to 15 how to say "no" by involving them in relevant discussions and activities to learn resistance and refusal skills, as well as how to develop assertiveness, strengthen decision-making skills and analyze media and peer influences. The ultimate goal is to promote abstinence from substance abuse and premature sexual activity through the practice of responsible behavior. Please note you're your child may wish to talk to you about some of the topics we'll address, including: decision-making and problem-solving; drugs, alcohol and tobacco abuse; adolescence and puberty; relationships, intimacy and sexuality; peer pressure, bullying and media literary; and family and community. As this program can discuss sensitive subject matter, including sexual content, please let me know if you would like to review the appropriate program guide in advance.
